This course is run by qualified Tutor Trainers Peter Dobson and Jean Jenkins and follows the N.S.R.A.'s Scheme, which is to train adults to supervise / train young people in safe use of airguns and basic target shooting techniques. The NSRA Diploma is awarded to successful participants and is a qualification required under POR for Leaders to supervise Scouts in air rifle shooting . It is valid for 5 years. The Law, safety rules, basic target shooting techniques, how an air gun works and its care, are covered in this course. A manual, containing all this content is provided for each participant.
